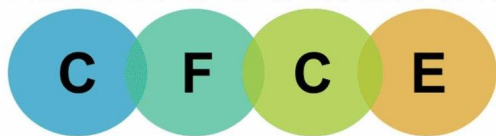

Who wants to go skiing?

Winter weather is on its way, which means it is time to dust off those skis, clip in to your bindings and hit the beautiful Colorado slopes. I forget how lucky we are living in this winter playground and getting to experience the mountains, trails and fluffy snow. Thanks to our CFCE supporters, we are also able to take the children in our program to enjoy the Colorado wonders through an adaptive ski program.

Several years ago, CFCE founders, Roxanne and Jim Waechter reached out to the adaptive ski program at Breckenridge to give the CFCE families an opportunity to experience skiing. Thanks to their partnership with BOEC (Breckenridge Outdoor Experience Center) we have been able to take 10 - 12 children into the mountains for a special ski lesson each year. We have also added a third ski day for the last 3 years up at Winter Park adaptive ski program too (NSCD).



Both BOEC and Winter Park NSCD have a range of equipment that allows every child to get up on the slopes, whether it is in a standing ski set up with outriggers, or in a bi-ski which allows the children to sit down and use their arms and core to lean side to side in order to make turns down the slopes.

The kids have so much fun on these ski days and it is thanks to the pledges we receive from our donors at the Golf Tournament in June this year that we are able to fund 10 children to attend each of our ski days. The CFCE families are so grateful to you, our supporters, for funding these lessons for them which they would otherwise not be able to do. Look out for our spring newsletter for pictures and updates on our ski adventures with the kids at CFCE.

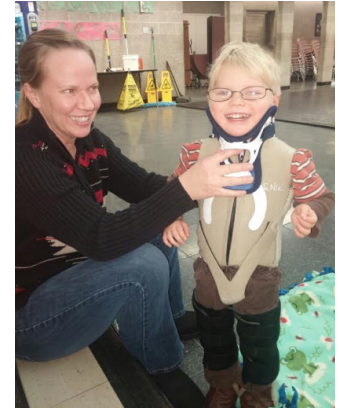

Meet a child at CFCE: Conn

Conn is a six year old little boy full of life and happiness who was born healthy and was developing fairly typically until, at 17 months old, he had an acute metabolic crisis that caused damage to the basal ganglia area of his brain. Doctors are still looking for a specific diagnosis. As a result of that damage he has overall low muscle tone with sporadic high tone. This means that without assistance he cannot sit up, hold up his head or use his limbs very effectively. He is also not able to eat by mouth or talk. He understands a lot of what is going on around him and expresses his opinions, sense of humor, knowledge and personality by using his eyes, smile and sounds to communicate. He likes all kinds of jokes and starts smiling as soon as he hears the beginning of a Knock-knock joke. He adores school because he gets to hang out with fun kids and teachers. He loves his brothers because they are entertaining in a loud, active and silly way that thrills him. Although he cannot talk he expresses himself with his eyes, his smile and his cry and he lets us know what he understands by following directions and reacting to humor, sadness, etc. We would love for him to be able to increase his access to the world by gaining more independence and strength in his movement, communicating with purposeful gestures/vocalizations and maybe even use a power wheelchair for some independent movement.



There is so much Conn cannot do but even more that he can do with the right kind of help and training. This is where Conductive Education comes in!! We heard about Conductive Education through researching different types of therapy and talking to his home therapists. What resonated with me the most about Conductive Education is that they treat the children's minds as well as their bodies. Conn may never need to know most of the academics taught in a traditional school but it is vital that his learning, curiosity and memory be challenged and developed along with the more obvious needs of his physical development. When he is at Conductive Education I love seeing him use his mind and body in conjunction through games, art projects and interacting with the people around him.
